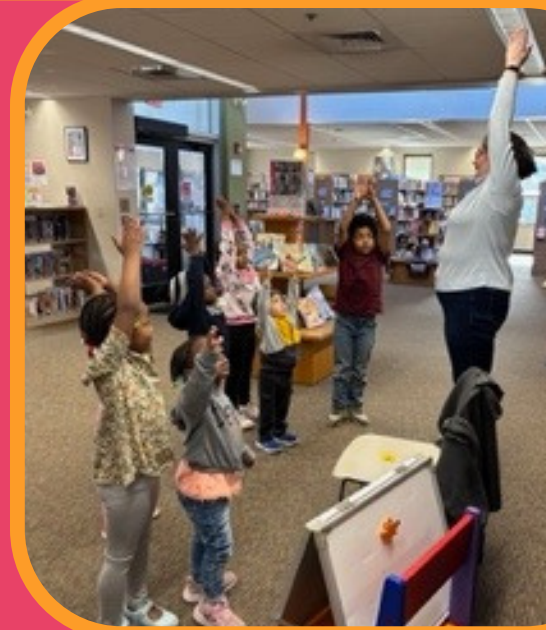
Our little learners shared laughs, smiles, and festive cheer while making unforgettable memories together during our December party.
